Water that runs down the **drain** in your **sink** or that you **flush** down the **toilet** makes its way through miles of pipes (we have over 400 miles of **pipe** in our system that allows us to serve customers) to the SFCSD Water Reclamation Facility. Here, we treat the water using **bugs** – tiny organisms that use a naturally occurring process to break down organic matter found in wastewater.

To help keep things running smoothly in our system and yours, we ask that the only things that go down your drains or toilets are the three P's – pee, poo and (toilet) paper. Fats, oils and grease (**FOG**) and items other than the three P's can create a **clog** somewhere along the way and result in damage or even sewer backups.
