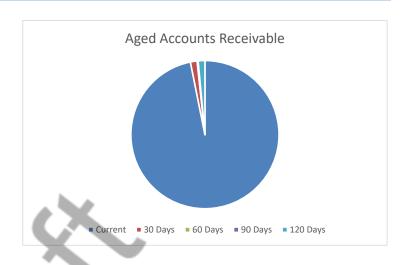

Re: New Billing Software Purchase

The District has been using Billmaster Utility Billing Software by DataWest for over 30 years. About 5 years ago, the DataWest Corporation was acquired by Harris Computer and the decision was made to no longer offer improvements to the Billmaster Software. While Harris would continue to support Billmaster users, updates would no longer be offered. Harris Computer has acquired several other Utility Billing Systems and is promoting a migration to one of their new billing platforms.

District staff researched a sampling of popular packages under the Harris umbrella and for potential new billing software vendors, while also polling other local water districts for feedback and recommendations. Over the past year, the search was narrowed down to three potential solutions: Tyler Technologies, Caselle, and inHance Utilities (under the Harris umbrella). Of these three candidates, only inHance is a Utility billing only software package, whereas Tyler and Caselle are ERP systems. An ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) system has the potential to support more than just utility billing. It can also grow to support Finance, Project Management, GIS, Backflow, and Service Orders, to name a few.

After two rounds of presentations from all three vendors, I can confidently recommend Tyler Technologies as the best fit for the District moving forward. They integrate with our current Sensus metering technology and offer real-time integration with several popular payment processors including having their own customer portal and payment processor. The platform itself is laid out using the same tabbing system that our customer service reps are familiar with and provides ample space for account notes and customer detail. The platform is only offered as a cloud based software; and therefore, there will be no on-premise computer services or database to manage.

The estimated timeline for implementation is approximately 12 - 18 months. We will maintain the Billmaster license for the next 2 years, allowing access to historical data as required by data retention regulations. The estimated implementation (one time) costs are \$114,700; the annual recurring licensing fees are \$46,514; for a total of \$254,242 for 2024. There is one optional item we recommend which is onsite implementation and training (\$6,400) and is included in the requested amount below. There are two optional items that we are unsure if we will take advantage of or not, and we may not know until we are further into implementation which are: cashiering at \$5,519; utility billing api toolkit at \$4,310. Since it is unknown if we will need these or not, I did include them in the requested amount below.

The contract has been reviewed by the General Manager and Finance Director. There are a number of items that align well with our cybersecurity stance (e.g. annual penetration testing). The contract still needs to be reviewed by legal and is in process.

Re: Zone 5 Transmission Project-Phase II-Allocation Request #03 (Fees)

Zone 5 is a 24" multi-phase transmission project stretching approximately 8 miles in Fort Collins that conceptually extends from the intersection of Horsetooth Road/Taft Hill Road east to Harmony Road/ Zeigler Road. The final alignment is still being evaluated and is subject to change Existing FCLWD infrastructure is undersized for current and future flow needs, resulting in dependence on pump stations and alternative water delivery sources. The Zone 5 project will increase hydraulic capacity and improve overall system performance and reliability throughout our service area, reducing our dependence on pump stations and alternative water delivery sources.

- Phase 1 of the Zone 5 Project (Manhattan Avenue and Troutman Parkway from Horsetooth Road to College Avenue-shown in dark blue below) was constructed in 2023.
- Phase 2 is anticipated to go to construction in the spring of 2024 and will extend from Horsetooth Road/Taft Road to Manhattan Avenue (shown in red below).

District staff has submitted the excavation permit through the City of Fort Collins Engineering Department for construction. As part of that permit, street impact/cut fees are expected to exceed \$130,000. This allocation request includes the anticipated fees with contingency that will come with permit approval. Staff will come back to the Board in May with an allocation request for the construction phase of the project.

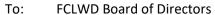
