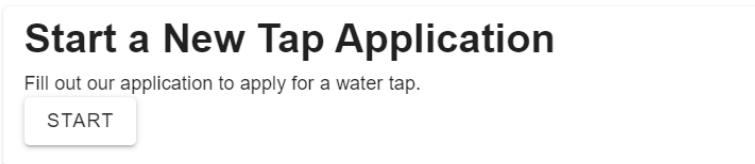




Thank you for applying for a water tap with the Fort Collins-Loveland Water District!

We have recently upgraded our technology and below are the instructions on how to apply for a water tap.

1. Navigate to <https://tapapp.fclwd.com/> and create an account with an email and password.
2. You will need access to this email in order to verify the email.
3. Once the account is set up, log into <https://tapapp.fclwd.com/>.
4. Click on the "Start" button.



5. Complete the information for the Applicant.
 - a. NOTE: Uncheck the box if the contact information is different than the applicant.
 - b. Click "Next"
6. Complete the Tap Location information.
 - a. NOTE: Parcel number can be obtained from Larimer County Assessor information. <https://www.larimer.gov/assessor/search#/property/>
 - b. Click "Next"
7. Select the type of tap to purchase.
 - a. Click "Next"
8. If the property is OWNED by Company/Estate/Trust, a statement of authority MUST be attached.
 - a. Click in the gray box.

Tap applications are reviewed on a first come, first served basis. The tap applications are reviewed by several departments and can take up to *two weeks to complete this review process* after the tap application is deemed to complete (e.g. application is completely filled out and correct statement of authority is attached).
