

PLAN TO BLOW OUT YOUR SPRINKLERS BEFORE THE FIRST FREEZE

As temperatures begin to drop this month, don't forget to blow out your sprinkler system. Failing to winterize before freezing temperatures hit can cause significant damage and lead to costly underground leaks.

If you have an air compressor, you may be able to do it yourself. Otherwise, a local sprinkler or irrigation professional can help.



The first frost occurs when temperatures dip between 32°F and 36°F, but the first freeze, when water in pipes can begin to expand and crack, happens at 32°F or below. Protect your system by blowing out the lines before the first freeze date.

Planning now helps avoid repairs later.
