

LOW WATER PRESSURE?

Here's what to check:

- **Clogged Faucets or Pipes:** Clean or replace clogged faucet aerators.
- **Closed Water Valve:** Check your main water valve. It may be partially closed.
- **Leaking Pipes:** Look for signs of leaks like damp spots or pooling water, which can lower pressure.
- **Corroded Pipes (Old Homes):** Over time, pipes can corrode and block water flow.
- **Pressure-Regulating Valve Issues:** If pressure fluctuates, the valve may need inspection.

Addressing these issues early can prevent costly repairs, save water and protect your plumbing. If you've ruled out these causes or notice other neighbors with similar issues, it could be a system-wide concern.
